Why Fundraise?

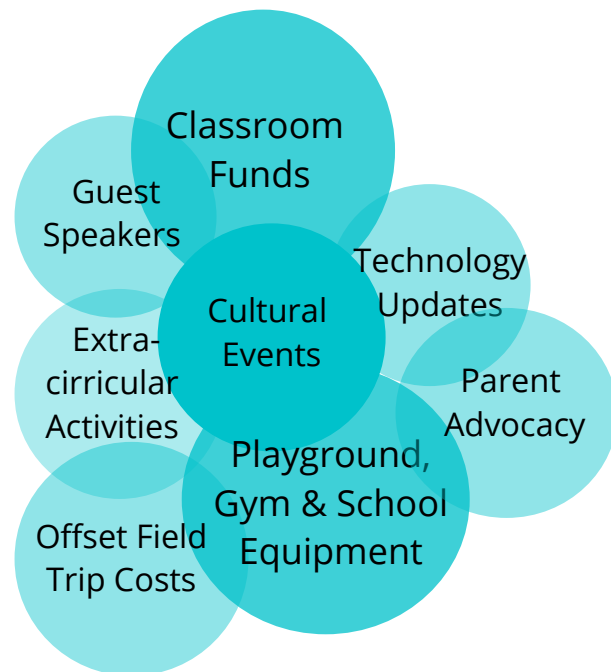
